37. **Leinburn 12, Speyside** **Price £4.00**  
Pear and rhubarb crumble sprinkled with Demerara sugar. Creamy brandy sauce and nutmeg. Finish of vanilla and salted caramel.
38. **Linkwood 15, Speyside** **Price £5.00**  
Quite full with balanced oak tannins and smoked ham. Palate full and firm with notes of oak. Finish quite long with a touch of spice.
39. **Longmorn 12, Speyside** **Price £4.50**  
Full of juicy fruit, apple peel, barley sugar and honey with notes of gentle smoke and dry oak. Good length with notes of barley and orange blossom honey.
40. **Macallan 10, Speyside** **Price £4.00**  
Nose of rubbed petals, apple blossom and hot pastries. Marmalade emerges on the tongue with notes of sherried peels, barley sugar and fudge. Medium length and oaky.
41. **Macallan 12, Speyside** **Price £5.00**  
Vanilla with hints of ginger, dried fruits, sherry and wood smoke. Deliciously smooth and balanced. Medium long sherry cask malt, which far outshines its younger cousin.
42. **Macallan 18 1967, Speyside** **Price £80.00**  
Dried fruits and ginger with a hint of citrus, vanilla and cinnamon. Full and lingering with dried fruits, toffee, ginger and a hint of wood smoke.
43. **Mannochmore 12, Speyside** **Price £5.00**  
Very delicate with notes of wild rose, honeysuckle, mint and marshmallows. Rich and fresh with spices, candied ginger, liquorice and vanilla. Satisfying, lingering, lushious.
44. **Milton Duff 10, Speyside** **Price £3.50**  
The nose is of medium body with notes of sherried peels, honeyed cigar box and tablet. Shades of spicy oak. Good finish with soft wood tapering out.
45. **Mortlach 15, Speyside** **Price £5.00**  
Rich with cereal sweetness and notes of apple blossom, malmsey and stewed fruits. Palate is full and sweet. Long with fruit spice and oak.
46. **Singleton 12, Speyside** **Price £4.00**  
Malty with barley sweetness, buttery toast, wood shavings, hay and walnuts. Orange zest, oaky rich with good length.
47. **Strathisla 12, Banffshire** **Price £4.00**  
Marmalade and hints of bourbon with a thick creaminess. The oak develops into the finish which is fruity and spirity.
48. **Strathmill 12, Speyside** **Price £5.00**  
Soft and very fruity and nutty, notes of cut herbs apples and hay. Smooth with spice, vanilla custard and a nutty oiliness. Soft, slightly herbal and peppery.
49. **Talisker 10, Isle of Skye** **Price £4.50**  
Thick pungent smoke with notes of kippers, seaweed and apple peels. Full bodied with huge plumes of smoke and peppery peat. Long finish.
50. **Tamnavoulin 12, Speyside** **Price £6.75**  
Soft with notes of malt extract, developing herbs and peppermint. Light well balanced with herbs, eucalyptus oil and barley sugar. Finish short with herbs and citrus fruit.
51. **Tomatin 12, Highland** **Price £3.50**  
Medium body and well balanced with notes of toasted cereals and barley, rum and apple peel. Good length with notes of boiled sweets.
52. **Tomintoul 16, Speyside** **Price £4.00**  
Medium bodied and punchy with notes of cut hay and dried grasses. Good length with notes of almond and barley sugar.
53. **Tormore 12, Speyside** **Price £3.50**  
Light and fresh with notes of cut hay and flowers. Hints of resin and pine oil, with toasted barley, cinnamon and pepper. Good length with a touch of oak and hay.



1. **Aberlour 10, Speyside** **Price £3.50**  
Sweet and full sherried raisins, hints of toffee and a pleasant nuttiness. Caramel and honey with lingering sweet spices.
2. **Aberlour 12, Speyside** **Price £5.00**  
Butter and Brown sugar on the nose. Oak and almonds on the tongue with a smooth burnt brown sugar finish.
3. **Aberlour 16, Speyside** **Price £5.50**  
Creamy and delectable. Sherry and oak in good harmony. Vanilla spices nicely ingrained in the barley. Soft and smooth with waxy notes and barley sweetness.
4. **Aberlour a'Bunadh Cask Strength 59%, Speyside** **Price £5.00**  
Incredibly spicy with hazelnuts and rich Oloroso sherry notes. Intense and oaky with peppered dark chocolate.
5. **Ardmore Traditional Cask, Aberdeenshire** **Price £4.00**  
Full of caramel with a hint of toasted oak and peat. Initial sharp edge gives way to sugary barley and a lanolin smoothness with more tapering smoke.
6. **Balmenach, 18, Speyside** **Price £5.00**  
Sugared candies with banana and marmalade. Malt Juniper and Pine. Strong with dried fruit, malt and sweet. Very long finish of bananas, malt, dried fruit and pepper.
7. **Balvenie Doublewood 12, Speyside** **Price £4.50**  
Sweet with good body, supple nuttiness and grapey. Dry, spicy beautifully warming.
8. **Balvenie Signature 12 Limited Release, Speyside** **Price £4.50**  
A little spiced rum opens up the nose with hints of date and walnut cake. The finish is tight and swift with bourbon oak notes fading out with toasty vanilla.
9. **Ben Nevis 10, Highland** **Price £3.00**  
Fresh and dry with hints of Seville marmalade and nutty undertones. Silken toffee and caramel notes with a touch of dark chocolate on the tail.
10. **BenRinnes 15 Partially triple distilled, Speyside** **Price £5.00**  
Fantastic interaction between toffee, spices and cinnamon with a backdrop of rum. Finish is an avalanche of rum and sultanas.
11. **Birnie Moss 48%, Benriach Speyside** **Price £4.00**  
This unique expression wields its peaty smoky character with precious vigour. A torrent of rich speyside peat in combination with vanilla and tropical fruits.
12. **Bowmore 15 SMWS Cask No 3.93, Islay** **Price £12.50**  
The aroma is burning heather moor with scented and floral notes. Taste of parma violets- sweet and perfumed. Candy charcoal and a mild coastal fragrance.
13. **Caperdonach 13, Speyside** **Price £6.25**  
Floral with herbal notes, creamy fudge, summer fruits with a subtle sherried edge. Initial burst of mixed spices, sweet with hints of shortbread. Pre-dinner dram.
14. **Cragganmore 12, Speyside** **Price £4.50**  
Aromatic floral, smoked almonds and hay. Rich, honey, stone fruits, nuts and berries. Good length, smoky and peppery finish.
15. **Dailuaine 16, Speyside** **Price £5.50**  
Rich with notes of cherry, licorice, oranges, plums, raisins and ginger. The finish is vegetal recalling orange pekoe and ginger. A light touch of smoke lingers on..
16. **Dalmore Dee Dram 2011/12, Rivers Collection, Highland** **Price £4.50**  
Lovely hints of orange over dark fruits, with a background of slightly sweet maltiness. Long, rich and smooth with some cherries.
17. **Dalmore Dee Dram 2010 Limited Edition 12, Highland** **Price £9.00**  
This attractively perfumed nose offers sweeter malt, thick cut orange marmalade and a hint of leather. Medium to long finish with dark fruit and light wood.
18. **Dalmore Spey Dram 2011/12, Rivers Collection, Highland** **Price £4.50**  
Cloves, spicy wood with a suggestion of bread dough with a lime twist at the end.
19. **Fettercairn Fasque, Aberdeenshire** **Price £4.50**  
Treacle toffee spices and pear. Taste of dark chocolate, coffee, cinnamon and nutmeg. Finish of rich vanilla and citrus fruits.
20. **Glenburgie 10, Speyside** **Price £3.00**  
The nose is quite full and rich with notes of sherried sultanas and dried mixed peel. Palate sweet with winter berries and mixed fruit. Gentle and supple finish.
21. **Glenfarclas 10, Speyside** **Price £4.00**  
Lots of sherry, juicy honey, with a touch of coffee and creamy barley. Finish is Long and spicy with fruity oak.
22. **Glenfarclas 15, Speyside** **Price £5.50**  
Intense powerful sherry, raisins, orange peel, walnuts and dates. Incredibly long, and complex. This is Christmas cake not whisky. Simply astonishing .
23. **Glenfarclas 105 Cask Strength 60%, Speyside** **Price £5.50**  
Great depth of sherry. Creamy and nutty, honey on toast with a touch of smoky coffee. Long, spicy, peppery and nutty with a glorious warming character.
24. **Glenfiddich 12, Speyside** **Price £3.50**  
Grainy, slightly floral, mineralitic. Spirity malty honey. Citrus develops. Sweet touch of oak and general fruit.
25. **Glenfiddich Solera Reserve 15, Speyside** **Price £4.50**  
Sherry, orange, drywood, raisins and spices. Candied fruit, Christmas pudding with oak taking over.
26. **Glenfiddich Caoran Reserve 12, (discontinued) Speyside** **Price £5.50**  
Glenfiddich with a twist of earthy smokiness. Rich and softly smoky with notes of orange and peat undertones.
27. **Glen Grant Majors Reserve, Speyside** **Price £3.00**  
Light and effervescent with cereal, peach and pears. Short with delicate fruit and wood notes.
28. **Glenlivet 12, Speyside** **Price £3.50**  
Sweet creamy vanilla with warm pastries and toffee. Fudge notes and aniseed. Long and warming finish.
29. **Glenlivet 18, Double Gold winner at IWSC, Speyside** **Price £5.50**  
Big and well rounded nose with notes of chewy sultanas and sherried peels, barley sugars and toasted cereals.
30. **Glemmorangie 10, Highland** **Price £3.50**  
Fruity and thick with rich notes of lemon, nectarine and apple. Long, spicy, fruity oak.
31. **GlenMoray 10, Speyside** **Price £3.00**  
Light fresh, nutty, floral and slightly fruity. Tangy citrus oak, well balanced.
32. **Highland Park, Orkney** **Price £3.50**  
Fresh clean and very aromatic with notes of creamy manuka honey and a touch of citrus. Quite long with peppered spice and wood shavings.
33. **Inchgower 14, Speyside** **Price £5.00**  
Light and delicate with notes of sugary citrus and stemmy hay. Palate fresh with hay, petals, spices and stem ginger. Spicy medium length finish.
34. **Jura 16, Bronze at IWSC, Isle of Jura** **Price £5.50**  
Light smoke sweetly transforms into creamy marzipan. Palate elegant vineous notes, orange zest with refreshing sour tangs. Medium to long with an orangy coating.
35. **Knockando 12, Speyside** **Price £4.50**  
Fruity-floral with a hint of blackcurrant and ash. Light but pleasantly sweet with a trace of citrus acidity. Light sweet and creamy fruit flavours. Pre dinner malt.
36. **Laphroig 10, Islay** **Price £3.50**  
Big smoky muscular peat with a dose of salt. Seaweed led with a hint of vanilla ice
