

45. **Macallan 12, Speyside** **Price £6.50**  
Classic Macallan, matured in Oloroso sherry seasoned oak casks.
46. **Mannochmore 12, Speyside** **Price £7.00**  
Very delicate with notes of wild rose, honeysuckle, mint and marshmallows. Rich and fresh with spices, candied ginger, liquorice and vanilla. Satisfying, lingering, luscious.
47. **Milton Duff 10, Speyside** **Price £5.50**  
The nose is of medium body with notes of sherried peels, honeyed cigar box and tablet. Shades of spicy oak. Good finish with soft wood tapering out.
48. **Mortlach 15, Speyside** **Price £7.50**  
Rich with cereal sweetness and notes of apple blossom, malmsey and stewed fruits. Palate is full and sweet. Long with fruit spice and oak.
49. **Old Pulteney 12, Highland** **Price £5.50**  
Robust, yet smooth with a hint of sea air
50. **Old Pulteney 17, Highland** **Price £10.50**  
A salty fruity complexity with pears and lemons to the fore and a near perfect balance of vanilla, barley and honey. This is a whisky that most distillers can only dream about.
51. **Old Pulteney 21, Highland** **Price £30.00**  
This must be one of the best Scottish malts whiskies. Salt, citrus, smoke, barley, toasted hazelnuts and maluka honey in a perfect formulation. Fantastic length.
52. **Royal Lochnagar 12, Highland** **Price £6.00**  
Nose of toffee, wood and a whiff of smoke with a taste of caramel, dry sherry, fruits and spice. Slightly scented finish.
53. **Singleton 12, Speyside** **Price £5.00**  
Malty with barley sweetness, buttery toast, wood shavings, hay and walnuts. Orange zest, oaky rich with good length.
54. **Springbank 10, Campbeltown** **Price £7.50**  
A full, sweet, creamy palate with hints of smoke, marzipan and cigar boxes.
55. **Strathmill 12, Speyside** **Price £7.00**  
Soft and very fruity and nutty, notes of cut herbs apples and hay. Smooth with spice, vanilla custard and a nutty oiliness. Soft, slightly herbal and peppery.
56. **Talisker 10, Isle of Skye** **Price £5.50**  
Thick pungent smoke with notes of kippers, seaweed and apple peels. Full bodied with huge plumes of smoke and peppery peat. Long finish.
57. **Tamdhu 10, Speyside** **Price £5.50**  
The palate bursts with fruit and spice – revealing toffee and the richness of sherry oak.
58. **Tamnavulin Double Cask** **Price £5.50**  
Soft with hints of sweet toffee, honey and marzipan, yet refreshing.
59. **Tamnavulin 12, Speyside** **Price £7.50**  
Very malty on the nose, with notes of vanilla, honey, walnuts and ginger.
60. **Tomatin 12, Highland** **Price £5.50**  
Medium body and well balanced with notes of toasted cereals and barley, rum and apple peel. Good length with notes of boiled sweets.
61. **Tomintoul 16, Speyside** **Price £7.00**  
Medium bodied and punchy with notes of cut hay and dried grasses. Good length with notes of almond and barley sugar.
62. **Tomintoul 14, Speyside** **Price £7.50**  
Light, fresh and fruity on the nose, with ripe peaches and pineapple cheesecake, delicate spice and background malt. Closer to barley sugar with the addition of water.
63. **Tormore 12, Speyside** **Price £7.00**  
Soft yet spicy attack with caramel, light character

1. **Aboyne Games Longmorn 14, Speyside** **Price £6.50**  
Medium bodied with a slightly drying feel. spicy notes combine with nutty undertones.
2. **Ardbeg 10, Islay** **Price £6.00**  
Sea spray, Tarry rope. Immense smoky intensity.
3. **Ardbeg Uigeadail, Islay** **Price £8.00**  
Awesome package of intense peat reek amid complex fruitcake and leather notes.
4. **Aberlour 10, Speyside** **Price £4.50**  
Sweet (caramel and honey) and full sherried raisins, hints of toffee and pleasant nuttiness.
5. **Aberlour 12, Doublecask Speyside** **Price £5.50**  
Butter and Brown sugar on the nose. Oak and almonds on the tongue with a smooth finish.
6. **Aberlour a'Bunadh Cask Strength 59%, Speyside** **Price £11.00**  
Spicy with hazelnuts and rich Oloroso sherry notes. Intense and oaky with dark chocolate.
7. **Ardmore Traditional Cask, Aberdeenshire** **Price £5.50**  
Full of caramel with a hint of toasted oak and peat. .
8. **Balmenach (Deerstalker), 18, Speyside** **Price £8.00**  
Very long finish of bananas, malt, dried fruit and pepper.
9. **Balvenie Doublewood 12, Speyside** **Price £5.50**  
Sweet with good body, supple nuttiness and grapey. Dry, spicy beautifully warming.
10. **Ben Nevis 10, Highland** **Price £6.50**  
Fresh and dry with hints of Seville marmalade and nutty undertones. Silken toffee and caramel notes with a touch of dark chocolate on the tail.
11. **BenRinnes 15. Partially triple distilled, Speyside** **Price £7.50**  
Fantastic interaction between toffee, spices and cinnamon with a backdrop of rum. Finish is an avalanche of rum and sultanas.
12. **Caperdonach 13, Speyside** **Price £17.50**  
Floral with herbal notes, creamy fudge, summer fruits with a subtle sherried edge. Initial burst of mixed spices, sweet with hints of shortbread. Pre-dinner dram.
13. **Cardhu Gold Reserve, Speyside** **Price £5.50**  
Rich texture and a balance of sweet fruit, dark chocolate, toffee, and spice.
14. **Cragganmore 12, Speyside** **Price £5.50**  
Aromatic floral, smoked almonds and hay. Rich, honey, stone fruits, nuts and berries. Good length, smoky and peppery finish.
15. **Dailuaine 16, Speyside** **Price £8.00**  
Rich with notes of cherry, liquorice, oranges, plums, raisins, and ginger. The finish is vegetal recalling orange pekoe and ginger. A light touch of smoke lingers on.
16. **Dalmore Dee Dram 2010 Limited Edition 12, Highland** **Price £17.00**  
This attractively perfumed nose offers sweeter malt, thick cut orange marmalade and a hint of leather. Medium to long finish with dark fruit and light wood.
17. **Edradour Straight from the Cask 58.9%, 10yo, Perthshire** **Price £8.50**  
Brown sugar, cherry, black currant, a ton of tobacco and clove.
18. **Glenburgie 10, Speyside** **Price £6.50**  
The nose is quite full and rich with notes of sherried sultanas and dried mixed peel. Palate sweet with winter berries and mixed fruit. Gentle and supple finish.
19. **Glenfarclas 10, Speyside** **Price £5.00**  
Lots of sherry, juicy honey, with a touch of coffee and creamy barley. Finish is long and spicy with fruity oak.
20. **Glenfarclas 15, Speyside** **Price £7.50**  
Intense powerful sherry, raisins, orange peel, walnuts and dates. Incredibly long, and complex. This is Christmas cake not whisky. Simply astonishing.
21. **Glenfarclas 105 Cask Strength 60%, Speyside** **Price £7.50**  
Great depth of sherry. Creamy and nutty, honey on toast with a touch of smoky coffee. Long, spicy, peppery and nutty with a glorious warming character.
22. **Glenfarclas 21, Speyside** **Price £14.00**  
Full of aromas – fruit, nuts, citrus and vanilla smokiness
23. **Glenfiddich 12, Speyside** **Price £5.00**  
Grainy, slightly floral, malty with honey. Citrus develops. Sweet touch of oak.
24. **Glenfiddich Solera Reserve 15, Speyside** **Price £6.50**  
Sherry, orange, drywood, raisins and spices. Candied fruit, Christmas pudding with oak.
25. **Glenfiddich Caoran Reserve 12, Speyside** **Price £20.00**  
Glenfiddich with a twist of earthy smokiness. Rich and softly smoky with notes of orange.
26. **Glen Grant Majors Reserve, Speyside** **Price £4.50**  
Light and effervescent with cereal, peach / pears. Short with delicate fruit and wood notes.
27. **Glen Grant 10, Speyside** **Price £6.50**  
Magnificent malty delivery with a granite like malt punch. The star perhaps are the complex sugars which are curiously honey free.
28. **Glen Grant 12, Speyside** **Price £7.00**  
Notes of fruit and caramel unfold with every sip.
29. **Glen Grant 18, Speyside Rare Edition** **Price £17.00**  
The most technically sublime Speyside Whisky
30. **Glenlivet 12, Speyside** **Price £5.00**  
Sweet creamy vanilla with warm pastries and toffee and aniseed. Long and warming finish.
31. **Glenlivet 15, French Oak** **Price £7.00**  
The palate is full and rich with winter spice; cinnamon and cloves. Rich and oaked.
32. **Glenlivet 18, Double Gold winner at IWSC, Speyside** **Price £12.50**  
Big and well-rounded with notes of chewy sultanas and sherried peels and toasted cereals.
33. **Glenlivet Ciper** **Price £17.00**  
Wonderful mix of cape gooseberry and pear with a distant hint of smoky bacon and vanilla.
34. **Glemmorangie 10, Highland** **Price £5.00**  
Fruity and thick with rich notes of lemon, nectarine and apple. Long, spicy, fruity oak.
35. **GlenMoray 10, Speyside** **Price £4.50**  
Light fresh, nutty, floral and slightly fruity. Tangy citrus oak, well balanced.
36. **Highland Park, Orkney** **Price £5.00**  
Fresh clean and very aromatic with notes of creamy manuka honey and a touch of citrus. Quite long with peppered spice and wood shavings.
37. **Inchgower 14, Speyside** **Price £6.50**  
Light and delicate with notes of sugary citrus and stemmy hay. Palate fresh with hay, petals, spices and stern ginger. Spicy medium length finish.
38. **Knockando 12, Speyside** **Price £6.50**  
Fruity-floral with a hint of blackcurrant and ash. Light but pleasantly sweet with a trace of citrus acidity. Light sweet and creamy fruit flavours. Pre dinner malt.
39. **Lagavulin 16, Islay** **Price £7.50**  
A tame spiciness generates a degree of hostility on the palate, but the mid ground sticks to a smoky coffee vanilla theme. Finish of light spicy waves in a gentle sea of smoke.
40. **Laphroig 10, Islay** **Price £5.50**  
Big smoky muscular peat with a dose of salt. Seaweed led with a hint of vanilla ice cream and more than a whiff of TCP from the first aid box.
41. **Leinburn 12, Speyside** **Price £6.00**  
Pear and rhubarb crumble sprinkled with Demerara sugar. Creamy brandy sauce and nutmeg. Finish of vanilla and salted caramel.
42. **Linkwood 12, Speyside** **Price £8.00**  
Quite full with balanced oak tannins and smoked ham. Palate full and firm with notes of oak. Finish quite long with a touch of spice.
43. **Longmorn 12, 2003 Speyside** **Price £7.50**  
Full of juicy fruit, apple peel, barley sugar and honey with notes of gentle smoke and dry oak. Good length with notes of barley and orange blossom honey.
44. **Macallan 10, Speyside (Classic Macallan out of production)** **Price £9.50**  
Nose of rubbed petals, apple blossom and hot pastries. Marmalade emerges on the tongue with notes of sherried peels, barley sugar and fudge. Medium length and oaky.
